- 10. Prizes**
Medals will be awarded to players who finish 1st, 2nd and 3rd. The winner/s of the 2018 National Hopes Boys' singles & the 2018 National Hopes Girls' Singles will receive entry to attend the 2018 ITTF Oceania Hopes Challenge (8–13 February 2018) in New Caledonia subject to eligibility according to ITTF regulations. In order to be granted entry into the 2018 Oceania Hopes Challenge and to receive TTA's financial contribution, the qualified player(s) must commit to their participation in the Oceania Hopes Challenge at the conclusion of the 2018 National Hopes Challenge. If the winner[s] are unable to attend the ITTF Oceania Hopes Challenge (8–13 February 2018) this will result in the entry being awarded to the next highest place finisher who is able to attend.

11. Format of Play

The 2018 Australian National Hopes Challenge Boys' Singles and Girls' Singles will be played in a two stage format, with a two stage Round Robin taking place with all athletes playing for final positions using the ITTF International Hopes Event/s format.

The Host Association, in consultation with the ITTF Expert, reserves the right to alter the proposed format of play if deemed necessary. All matches will be best of five games.

12. Provisional Schedule

Monday 22nd – Thursday 25th January 2018

Health, Wellness and Table Tennis Head coach Patrick Wuertz will conduct a four (4) day training camp leading in to the event. Training camp sessions will be held at 9:30am and 2:00pm each day at the LOOPS Stadium in West Sunshine. HWATT will provide several training options and partners during the event including past International Hopes participants Zaki Zenaidee, Finn Luu, Chermaine Quah and Hannah Green. Full attendance at Training Sessions is mandatory for athletes; full attendance at Coach Education and Talent ID sessions is mandatory for Coaches.

Friday 26th January 2017 (8:30am – 7:00pm)

13. Weather

January falls right in the middle of summer in Melbourne. The average daytime high for this time of the year is a warm 26°C. However, a light jacket may be needed at night with temperatures falling to a daily low of 15°C. Overall, the average daily temperature is 21°C.

14. Racket Control

ITTF rules regarding rackets and racket coverings will be enforced. No gluing or re-gluing of rackets is permitted in the playing venue. The ITTF Equipment Committee strongly recommends all players to make certain that new coverings are aired 72 hours before use.

15. TTA Licence Fee

A TTA licence fee of \$8.80 per player is included with the entry fees and will be payable by the host association.

16. Clothing

ITTF and TTA Clothing regulations will be enforced. The main colour of shirts or shorts must not be white. Players should be neatly dressed, and not wear any clothing that might cause offence or bring the game into disrepute. Nominated doubles pairs from the same Association should be dressed uniformly.

17. Information
